

# Download Minolta Manual Focus Slr Cameras

The Minolta A-mount camera system was a line of photographic equipment from Minolta. The system used a lens mount called A-mount, with a flange focal distance 44.50 mm. The new mount was larger than the older SR-mount making old manual lenses incompatible with the new system. The mount is now used by Sony, who bought the SLR camera division from Konica Minolta, Konica and Minolta having merged ...Minolta Co., Ltd. (????, Minoruta) was a Japanese manufacturer of cameras, camera accessories, photocopiers, fax machines, and laser printers. Minolta was founded in Osaka, Japan, in 1928 as Nichi-Doku Shashinki Sh?ten (???????, meaning Japanese-German camera shop). It is perhaps best known for making the first integrated autofocus 35mm SLR camera system. (1985-) Sadly, one of the least sharp f/1.7 lenses around. 49mm filters, built-in hood, 1.5'/0.45m close focus, 6.435 oz./182.4g, +1.0 distortion at 3 meters.
